



MANAGEMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE INTERNATIONALISATION OF HIGHER EDUCATION

"Internationalisation of a higher education institution is defined as a change process from a national higher education institution to an international higher education institution leading to the inclusion of an international dimension in all aspects of its holistic management in order to enhance the quality of teaching and learning and to achieve the desired competencies" (Soderqvist, 2002, p. 29).



Whether you are new to institutional leadership or are looking to improve upon your existing skills, this program will help set you up for success. The MasterClass will work through different aspects of higher education internationalisation critical to the process of institutional internationalisation.

In addition to the classroom sessions, you will have time to network with your fellow higher education practitioners during the group discussion sessions, breaks and our networking reception. We encourage you to take full advantage of this opportunity to build relationships with your peers from other institutions.

Completing the course will provide you with the following skills:

- Have insight into the different dimensions and challenges of leading internationalisation at different institutional levels.
- Understand the challenges facing leaders of higher education institutions in the implementation of a Comprehensive Internationalisation strategy.
- Be able to discuss the meaning of the concepts globalisation, nationalism and internationalisation of higher education.
- Explain the nature of internationalisation, an internationalisation strategy and comprehensive internationalisation; and
- Provide you with the skills and insights to implement higher education internationalisation at academic and professional units within a higher education institution.

The MasterClass will be facilitated by experienced higher education and internationalisation of higher education specialists.
